FLU SEASON REMINDERS

Flu season is upon us, so please help us keep our children well! We will be doing our part to stop the spread of germs in the classroom. We ask that you please review our sickness and new guidelines policy and help us to keep everyone healthy this winter!

Country Village is designed for the well child. We ask for your assistance in helping us keep a healthy school. Please do not send your child to school unless he/she is feeling well and is ready for a busy day.

Communicable Diseases:

In order to prevent the spread of communicable illnesses, take the time in the morning to observe your child. If a child has a cough and/or a runny nose, he can be contagious and should stay home. If a child has been sent home with a fever accompanied by other symptoms, he needs to stay home one extra day after the temperature has returned to normal. The extra day is standard policy for most illnesses and will help insure your child's recuperation and the health and safety of the other children.

If your child becomes ill at school, we will contact you. Children who become ill at school will be brought to the front lobby to rest until they are picked up from school. If we cannot reach the numbers you have listed, we will call the emergency numbers as you have directed. Be sure to keep your emergency numbers current. Your child is counting on you. Thank you to all of our families for your help and understanding.



A child that has started on antibiotics needs to be taking the prescribed dose for 48 hours and be well before returning.

Country Village will provide information to families both verbally and in writing about any unusual level or type of communicable disease to which their child was exposed. This communication will include signs and symptoms of the disease, mode of transmission, the period of communicability, and the control measures that are being implemented at the school.
