

Late Fee Reminders

As a reminder, a \$10 an hour late fee will be



applied for our Half and Extended Day Programs in order to discourage late pick-ups. This fee will be applied for pick-ups after 12PM and 3PM. Due to staffing and ratios we ask that all families respect the pick-up times of your child's program. If your child is 9am-3pm they MUST be picked up no later than 3pm; if your child is 9am-12pm they MUST be picked up no later than 12pm. We cannot promise special drop-in accommodations without prior approval. Pick-ups after 6PM will accrue \$2.00 for every minute late. These charges will appear on monthly tuition statements. If you would like a copy of this amendment, please feel free to stop by the office. Thank you for helping us ensure the safety of your children and thank you for helping us keep our staff within ratio.

FLU SEASON REMINDERS

Flu season is upon us, so please help us keep our kiddos well! We will be doing our part to stop the spread of germs in the classroom. We ask that you please review our sickness policy and help us to keep everyone healthy this winter!

Country Village is designed for the well child. We ask for your assistance in helping us keep a healthy school. Please do not send your child to school unless he/she is feeling well and is ready for a busy day.

Communicable Diseases: In order to prevent the spread of communicable illnesses, take the time in the morning to observe your child. If a child has a cough and/or a runny nose, he can be contagious and should stay home. If a child has been sent home with a fever accompanied by other symptoms, he needs to stay home one extra day after the temperature has returned to normal. The extra day is standard policy for most illnesses and will help insure your child's recuperation and the health and safety of the other children.



A child that has started on antibiotics needs to be taking the prescribed dose for 48 hours and be well before returning.

Country Village will provide information to families both verbally and in writing about any unusual level or type of communicable disease to which their child was exposed. This communication will include signs and symptoms of the disease, mode of transmission, the period of communicability, and the control measures that are being implemented at the school.

If your child becomes ill at school we will contact you. Children who become ill at school will be brought to the front lobby to rest until they are picked up from school. If we cannot reach the numbers you have listed, we will call the emergency numbers as you have directed. Be sure



to keep your emergency numbers current. Your child is counting on you.
